
MAKARA PEAK MOUNTAIN BIKE PARK

CREEK TO PEAK RELAY

This is a two-lap, two-person relay race. The first team member will ride the approx 12km lap, then pass the team number to the second rider who completes the same lap and crosses the finish line.

Each lap climbs to the top of the park via Koru, Sally Alley, Missing Link and Aratihi, and returns via the 4WD track, Lower Ridgeline and then for the first time, Lazy Fern - some of the sweetest single track in New Zealand!

TOUR DE PEAK

This event is for intermediate and experienced riders and is designed to test fitness, riding skills and route selection. All tracks must be ridden in a designated direction but which route you take is up to you. In 2007 there will be four grades to choose from:

Recreational: Koru, Sally Alley, Lower Ridgeline, Magic Carpet, Lazy Fern, SWIGG and Starfish

Super Sport: Koru, Sally Alley, Magic Carpet, Live Wires, Lazy Fern, Missing Link, Upper Leaping Lizard, Leaping Lizard, Possum Track, Nikau, Aratihi, Zacs, Varleys, Upper Ridgeline, Lower Ridgeline, SWIGG and Starfish

Open: Ride every track in the park including Vertigo and Trickle Falls (unless wet).

Duo: Team of two riders ride all tracks in the park between them, including Vertigo

and Trickle Falls (unless wet).
